Nursery News

Winter is almost here and we are frost-proofing, with our fingers crossed! The shade house holds about 65 forest species, most at seedling stage.

We are using a mix of old log

dump soil and leaf litter, collected from the forest, then sifted and composted on site. The plants love it.

The fast-growing pioneer species - like wattle, tea tree, banksia, callistemon, casuarina and calicoma, will be ready for Spring. They are good protection for later plantings of rainforest trees shrubs, and groundcovers.

GARDENING

New garden beds have been built, and weeds cleared. We've



been planting fruit, vegetables, herbs, native shrubs and grasses. Keen gardeners are invited to help rejuvenate the Showground Nursery site, and share their local knowledge and ideas.

MAKING SOIL

Straw, sawdust and manure from the showground sheds are composting on site. Suggestions and help are welcome on how to make great soil and bag it for the keen gardeners.

CHECK YOUR SHEDS

We can RE-USE and RECYCLE: Waxed boxes, plastic plant trays, wheelbarrows, hoes, garden ornaments, rocks and water features, compost bins, old feed bags.
