Dandarrga Landcare Nursery Wish List & Working Bees

Storage, Power

Secure storage for tools and equipment. Small shed space has automatic watering system, which needs an electrician to check the damaged power-point, see if we can program the system and make it work. Also be good to have a place to make cuppas.

Water & Irrigation

Could use a couple of <u>hoses</u>, maybe install a separate <u>tap</u> near the small greenhouse and use <u>sprinklers and a timer</u>. The main tap needs a <u>washer</u>

Composting

Sites for compost bays are to the right of the front gate, and further along the fence line – need to check with tenants of the caretaker's house about their back gate and access. <u>Horse manure and hay from the stables</u> – we need access and <u>a ute or trailer</u> to transport it to our composting bays.

<u>Materials on site</u> we could use for bays <u>– timber, wood frames with reo</u> (in the big greenhouse), <u>old shadecloth, star pickets, roll of rabbit wire</u>.

<u>Roofing needed</u>, mostly alsanite, and some corrugated iron to create shade. Framing <u>timber for roof battens</u>

<u>Shadecloth</u> – Barry has some, there is some on site, might need more. Could use the roll of <u>rabbit wire</u> to make more <u>secure walls</u>, otherwise need <u>light</u> <u>framing timber</u> for walls too.

Need to move the middle potting bench to create a central space, also move the <u>benches</u> <u>outside</u> to create access between and around them.

Barry could <u>make a portable mini tunnel</u> with shadecloth to attach to the outside benches, and be used for market stalls.

<u>Tools</u>

2 x light poly wheelbarrows; Poly plastic tubs for propagating; Shallow plastic trays to hold water

Stools – Rosie has some to donate

<u>First Aid Kit</u> – will purchase online with grant from RAB, also PPE like <u>gloves</u>, <u>masks and</u> <u>goggles</u>.
