



Bird and Weeds Walk and Talk Sessions - Dungog

Find out more about what species – native and introduced – are present on Dungog Common and in the general Dungog Shire area.

This event is ideal for those interested in birds and other wildlife, and in the impact that local weeds have on the land and on other species.

Session 1: Join Dungog Common Landcare members as they lead you on a morning bird spotting walk and hear about recorded sightings of the wildlife using the Common.

Session 2: Hunter LLS and Dungog Council staff will lead a session on common problem weeds in the Dungog Shire and how to control them with examples of treatment work undertaken by Dungog Common Landcare.

Participants are welcome to join either one or both sessions.

A detailed program will be provided upon booking.

Directions to location: Enter Dungog Common off Common Road which leads off from Hooke Street coming from the central Dungog township, or from Wangat Road. Look for the marquee area.

What to bring: A hat, suitable footwear for bushwalking, a fold-up chair, water and sunscreen. If participating in the bird walk session bring a pair of binoculars if you have them, otherwise binoculars can be loaned on the day.
