The Friends of the Mongarlowe River is a local rivercare group established in 1986. FMR's aspiration is to keep the Mongarlowe River in a pristine state. In 2007 FMR undertook a riparian assessment of the river to research the endangered Macquarie Perch. The assessment noted a severely eroded bank at this site, and so developed 'The Bank Job' riverbank rehabilitation project, undertaken with funding from the
