The Greater Sydney Landcare Network (GSLN) aims to be the regional umbrella organization for Landcare, Bushcare and other 'care' groups and individuals across greater Sydney.

GSLN wants to promote to the wider community the values of Landcare and Bushcare, and to increase the understanding, recognition and support to the work that land-caring volunteers, professional bush regenerators and related organisations do for the greater Sydney region.

GSLN aims to be a bridge between professionals and non-professionals in the environmental field, and a **voice** for land-carers at a volunteer level.

Greater Sydney Landcare Network Projects

- The Cumberland Plain Landcare Program offers monthly Landcare events that support Bushcare and Landcare groups in western Sydney. These events bring more volunteers, funding, catering, training and promotion to groups (and sites) who need it.
- Intrepid Landcare has landed in Sydney with the help of Greater Sydney Landcare Network's Leadership Retreats. This is a program that empowers and mentors young adults into fun and adventurous Landcare projects of their own. It encourages young adults into the land-caring movement across Svdnev.
- Cattai Hills Environment Network (CHEN) has been born with the support of Greater Sydney Landcare Network (GSLN). It is a passionate group of Hills Shire residents wanting to protect and enhance the environment, particularly in the Cattai and Little Cattai Creek catchments.
- Encouraging **sustainable agriculture** in the Sydney Basin is another priority of GSLN. Through a series of workshops in South Western Sydney, GSLN is coordinating capacity building to farmers with weed identification and control, focusing on weeds that are toxic to stock.
- Networking with all environmental education networks across Sydney, GSLN is also making itself available for **school** environmental and sustainability education, while developing land-caring resources for schools and educators online.
