ALERT!!!

Tropical Soda Apple is again rearing its spikey head. If you see this plant you must:

- Notify the local control authority –
 Rous County Council 02 66233800
- Destroy the plants including the fruit. Recommended methods include 200ml of glyphosate in 10 litres of water for spot spray application and 1 part glyphosate per 1.5 parts of water for cut stump application.
- Ensure the land is kept free of the plant.
