## Horseshoe Creek

Work continues between the two bridges along Horseshoe Creek. A dedicated group of volunteers continue to meet and work on this important wildlife corridor every third Sunday of the month. The Regional Weed Co Ordinator has been out to conduct an assessment of a new bio security threat; Job's Tears. Job's Tears is currently an unlisted threat, however has the potential to "clog" Horseshoe Creek and potentially affect the health of the Richmond River. As well as Job's Tears the major threats to the health of this waterway are Madeira Vine, Balloon Vine, Giant Devils Fig as well as the usual suspects – Lantana and Crofton Weed. Next working bee is Sunday the 19<sup>th</sup> August. Meet at 9am 823 Horseshoe Creek.
