#### Notes

(1) At 30/6/22, MLG had three bank accounts - a main operating account that receives revenue and is used for occasional large outlays, an account allowing the treasurer to make EFT payments and a term deposit.

(2) Nursery income was separately identified from 2016-17. Expenditure was separately identified from 2011-12. Nursery income includes Michael King grants.

(3) The composition of this item has varied over the years. From 2016-17, it includes bank fees and refunds. From 2017-18, it also includes petty cash allowance and myna bird expenditure. In 2021-22, bank fees were attributed to the relevant category where applicable.

(4) From 2012, *Non-financial members* excludes long-term non-financials, who are presumed to be effectively lapsed. Periodically, these members are contacted and removed from our mailing lists if they are not interested in being involved. There were 21 long-term non-financials removed from our membership list in early December.

(5) From 2016, the membership year was changed to start at 1 July instead of 1 September.

(6) Corporate members are separately identified and include related organisations, such as Greening Australia and Friends of Grasslands. They do not pay subscriptions. Data are not available before 2018. Additional corporate members were added in 2019 following a reconciliation with Yass Area Network mailing lists.
