Araluen Creek Restoration Project

The Araluen Creek Restoration Project is funded by the Bushfire Community Recovery and Resilience Fund through the joint Commonwealth/State Disaster Recovery Funding. The project aims to deliver in stream works that will support the creek and its environs into the future.

Project Update

Soil Conservation Service construction work is scheduled to begin in March. Works to be undertaken include; log sill weirs, rock ramps, removing choke points and realigning stream diversions. The remediation of 11 sites will deliver stability, reduce sediment movement, control erosion and future bank collapses. Local videographer, Clare Young will be showcasing the project and producing an informative video reference for the future.
