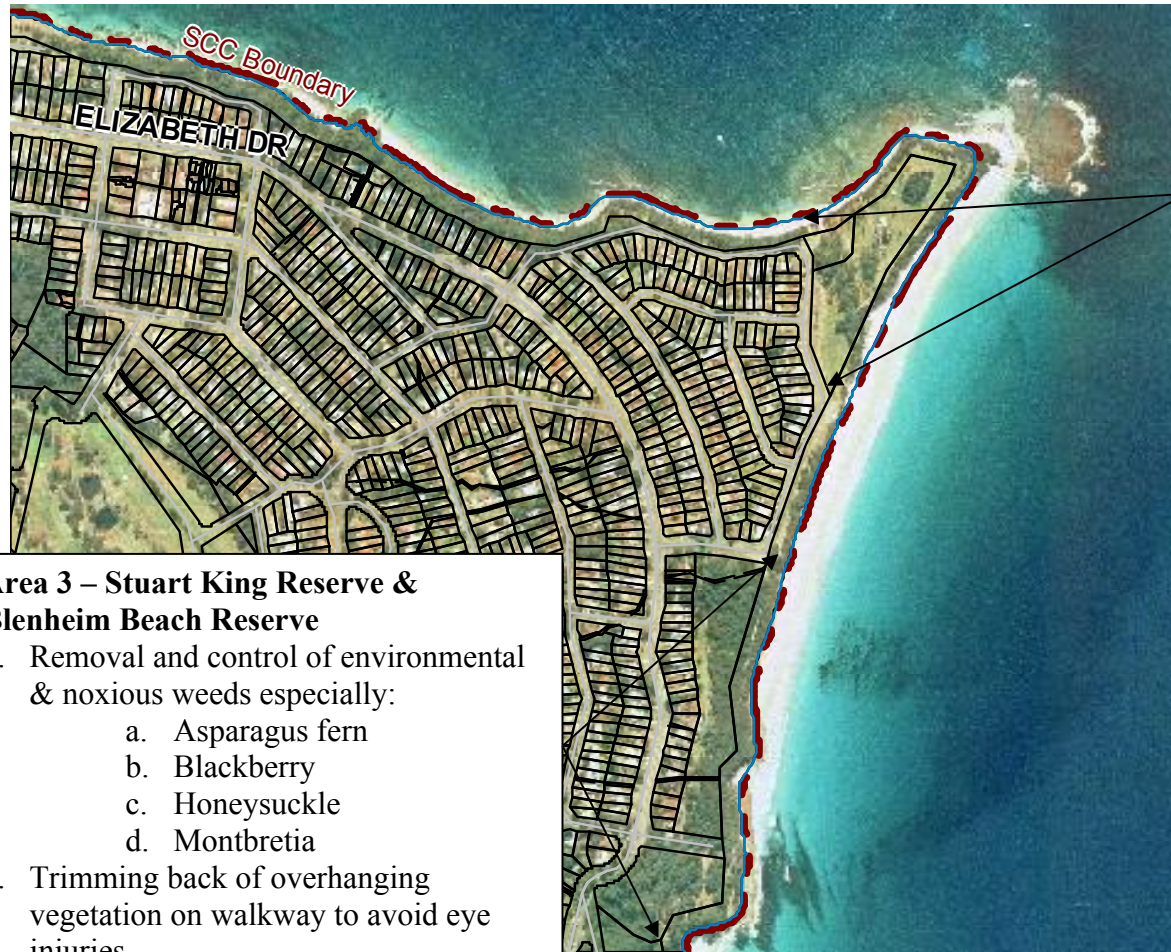

Area 3 – Stuart King Reserve & Blenheim Beach Reserve

1. Removal and control of environmental & noxious weeds especially:
 - a. Asparagus fern
 - b. Blackberry
 - c. Honeysuckle
 - d. Montbretia
2. Trimming back of overhanging vegetation on walkway to avoid eye injuries

Area 1 Plantation Point Foreshore Areas – Boat ramp to boundary of Nelson Beach Foreshore Parkcare Group boundary as per Council resolution.

1. Monitor and remove re-growth Mother of Millions
2. Spot spray Buffalo grass in fenced foreshore veg areas with 1:100 ratio of Glyphosate/water .in the winter months..
3. Maintain 1 meter mulch buffer area by spot spraying Buffalo grass.
4. Supplement plant foreshore veg area behind dune fence with primarily under story plants (see reveg species list) and collect seed to propagate at Booderee Bot Gardens.
5. Installation of Council Bushcare sign describing groups activities.
6. Installation of “Regeneration Area Please Keep Off” signs at various location along foreshore fence line
7. Council to replace *Calurpa taxifolia* sign boat ramp
8. Seek assistance from Noxious Weeds unit to spray large Yucca plants
9. Assist Council with establishing vegetation islands, by spraying kikuyu, installing bollards at 5m intervals and planting low growing shrubs and groundcovers, to link up large shade trees in the newly acquired land.
