Araluen Creek Water Testing

Water testing at 6 sites on the Araluen Creek from the Majors Creek escarpment to its confluence with the Deua River is continuing on a regular basis -3^{rd} Sunday of the month.

Tony Hayman is correlating the testing results and creating a record that can be used to identify dramatic changes in water temperature, turbidity, electrical conductivity and ph.
